Attorney William D. (Pat) Campbell, of



Toronto, Ohio was born March 17, 1925, St. Patrick's Day, hence the name "Pat". He served in the Navy during WW II, graduated from The Ohio State University School of Law in 1949 and was an attorney in Steubenville for over 50 years. He was a member of the Empire United Methodist Church, past

president of the Jefferson County Bar Association and a member of numerous organizations.

In 1998, while fishing in the Ohio River, he turned in the boat and his femur broke. A later biopsy of the femur showed the presence of Non-Hodgkin's Lymphoma. Pat underwent chemotherapy and radiation treatments from 1999 to 2002 at the Teramana Cancer Center. Treatment involved numerous hospital stays, doctors' appointments and checkups.

Pat's chemotherapy was effective in treating his cancer. However, the chemotherapy did a great deal of damage to his heart. His heart became extremely enlarged and this condition required extensive treatment.

Pat received a pacemaker in September, 2009, returned to the hospital in October, 2009 and died December 10, 2009. The damage to his heart was too great and it could no longer function.

His wife Patricia and son David are pleased that the Campbell name can help promote the Trinity Foundation TEAR Fund that provides financial assistance to cancer patients in need.
